## **1. Event Participation**

By registering for and participating in the **Tech Run for the Eldoret Investor Forum**, all participants agree to comply with the event rules and guidelines set forth by the organizers. These rules are designed to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants.

## **7. Use of Data by Third Parties**

## **8. Event Cancellation and Modification**

## **9. Race Bibs and Timing Devices**

Participants must wear their official race bibs and any timing devices provided by the organizers throughout the event. Bibs must be clearly visible at all times. Participants are responsible for ensuring their bibs are properly secured and timing devices are functional. Lost or damaged bibs or devices may incur additional requests for replacement.

## **10. Code of Conduct**

All participants are expected to behave respectfully toward other participants, volunteers, and event officials. Any form of unsportsmanlike conduct, including littering, harassment, or failure to follow instructions from event staff, may result in disqualification from the event.

## **11. Minors and Guardians**

Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. The adult accompanying the minor accepts full responsibility for the minor's safety and well-being during the event. By signing up for the event, guardians agree to the terms and conditions on behalf of the minor.

## **12. Amendments**

The organizers reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice. Participants will be notified of any significant changes via email or other communication channels. Continued participation in the event constitutes acceptance of any revised terms.

## **13. Agreement**
